John Griffith, he made the following comments, referencing the dedication of our Church members who devotedly support the Church, and its auxiliaries, including the Ladies' Circle. He stated, "Their dedication even to travel in less than favorable conditions to attend a local Circle meeting speaks volumes to we who may only get to a few meetings or just the Semi-annual General Circle Meeting. Sisters count on each other and the Spirit of God draws them closer together to a special fellowship. Know without question that the women of our Church are created and called of God into His service. How much better can we glorify Him than by having our life taken during our time of service to Him? Thank God for our Sisters who hold the Circle's banner of service high for other women to see. May each of us have that same dedication of Church support and the respect for the needs of others. God bless one and all who especially take that extra step to make a difference and raise the spiritual bar of servitude."
